Age:

There is a new cut of date for eligibility for the 2012-2013 season. For minimum age on teams, you must be the required age by August 31, 2012. This will determine your "competition age." Please bring a copy of your birth certificate for Chico Cheer All Stars to have on file.

Levels:

There are 6 levels this season. The "level" refers to the type of stunts, pyramids, and tumbling that a team can safely perform. They are numbered from 1-6, in increasing difficulty. The level is determined solely by the coaching staff.

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Placement:

There may be athletes on any given team that tumble at a different level than the rest of their teammates. We try to match up the athletes by level as best we can, but please remember that stunting, pyramids, jumps, dance, motions, and age are huge factors as well. Some will be stronger tumblers than others. Some will contribute more with stunts than others. We chose our team based on the positions that we need to fill (Bases, flyers, tumblers, etc.) Every athlete is on the team for a reason - please trust the staff. Our teams have always done well.



TUITION (June-April):

\$100 per month for ALL TEAMS except PREP & OPEN COED TEAM. This includes 1 hour of Mandatory Tumbling (for Junior, Senior, & Open Teams) each week and ALL competition fees! Due to our low costs we do not currently offer a sibling discount.

PREP Team is only \$50 per month and OPEN CO-ED 5 TEAM is only \$25 per month. This includes practices and ALL competition fees! Crossovers to these teams must pay both tuitions.

Crossovers Levels 1-3: At tryouts you may be asked to try out for a higher level team in addition to the team your age eligible for. If you are asked to try out for a higher level team you must continue your age eligible team and have the choice to cheer on an additional team as a 'crossover'. This will result in an additional 'crossover fee' of \$25 fee per month.

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Pay tuition for June - April in May 2012 up front and deduct 5% of your total!!

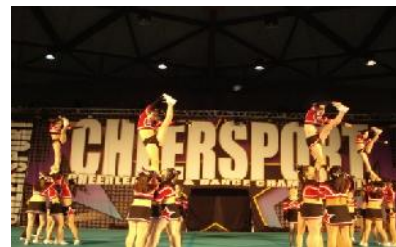

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- ✿ If you need assistance or answers to anything, please contact us!
- ✿ We are committed to you and we will provide the best customer service to our athletes and families!
- ✿ Do not make assumptions about anything. Always ask.
- ✿ Attitude is everything. If an athlete has a foul attitude, we will place him/her to a non-competitive program, such as a class, until improvements are made. Until then, a replacement will be put in position.
- ✿ Do not call or text the staff unless it is an emergency. The staff needs to have their personal time away from work. Thank you in advance for respecting this rule.
- ✿ All cell phones must be turned off once practice starts.
- ✿ All clothing and belongings must be stored in the cubbies, not thrown on the floor.
- ✿ Do not bring items of value to the gym. (IPOD, jewelry, IPHONE etc...) we are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- ✿ Siblings of athletes cannot come inside the gym and watch practice unattended. An adult in the viewing area must supervise them. We are not baby-sitters.
- ✿ No one is allowed to yell onto the floor or make contact with our athletes during practice.
- ✿ You cannot create or sell your own Chico Cheer clothing. Our name and logo is copyrighted. All ideas for apparel must be emailed and approved by the Director.
- ✿ The only people allowed on the floor are staff members and athletes that are on the team rosters. Parents, friends, relatives and siblings must remain in the viewing area.
- ✿ Anyone threatening to quit will be asked to leave immediately. No refund will be given.
- ✿ Your opinion regarding practice and routine construction does not count. The staff makes all the decisions.
- ✿ DO NOT GOSSIP about other teams, parents, other gyms or kids. Again, if you have questions ASK, rather than listen to non-sense or engage in irresponsible conduct.
- ✿ It is the parent's responsibility to stay informed. Check your email and website regularly. If you aren't receiving emails, contact the Gym Director ASAP. Every month, you should receive a minimum of one email.
- ✿ A dress code will be enforced during practice.
- ✿ SHOES MUST BE WORN at practice. A \$5 fee will be issued if shoes are not worn.
- ✿ A \$25 fine or 15 min. conditioning will result in an unexcused absence.
- ✿ Absences must be cleared by the Head Coach, more than 3 in a season results in removal from team.
- ✿ Coaches/Directors reserve the right to close practices at any time. This only occurs if the viewing area becomes negative or distracting.
- ✿ Withholding your child from practice cannot be used as a form of discipline. This is unfair to the rest of the team.
- ✿ Do not post negative comments, routines or music on message boards, You Tube or any website.
- ✿ Always exemplify good sportsmanship, positive conduct and professionalism at all competitions and practices.
- ✿ No profanity or rude language.
- ✿ Punctuality is a MUST. Arrive 10 minutes early to all practices, competitions and functions.
- ✿ If you are late or dressed incorrectly, you will condition/jump after practice.
- ✿ Practice schedule can change and may be added before competition.
- ✿ No food or drinks other than bottled drinks are allowed in the gym.
- ✿ Remove all piercings. This is not negotiable. This is a safety issue!
- ✿ Feel free to talk to your coach about anything. We want to make sure the line of communication is open. However, there is an appropriate time. Email or call the gym to make an appointment.
- ✿ If you have questions, please use the following chain of command:
Front Desk → Team Coach → Director/Owner

Team/Athlete Policies



Absences: Attendance is crucial to team success. An absence must be called in prior to the missed practice. No practice can be missed 2 weeks prior to choreography or any competition. No competition or event can be missed for any reason

Excused Absences:

- ✿ Contagious Illness
- ✿ School function that affects grade
- ✿ Death in the family
- ✿ Vacation during summer

Unexcused Absences:

- School Dance
- Traffic
- Too much homework
- Don't have a ride

Tardies: DON'T BE LATE, please.

Vacations: Vacations are not permitted during competition (Dec - April) season, unless the gym is closed and the athlete has already cleared it with their coaches. Please see your coaches with any vacations at any time. Also, any summer vacations must be in writing 2 weeks prior to the missed practice.

Injuries: If an injury should occur, it is the responsibility of the parent to seek professional help. Each athlete must have his/her own medical insurance. After seeing a physician, please provide Chico Cheer with an evaluation of the athlete's injury/status. A release from a doctor is required if a serious injury should occur.

Travel/Competitions: During the competition season, cheerleaders will be asked to travel. Some athletes will travel to national events out of state. In this case, cheerleaders must travel with the team. Transportation to all local competitions, including those located in Southern California is the responsibility of each team member and his/her family. All Team members will wear Chico Cheer clothing to each function. Uniform articles should be packed neatly into your team bag. All team members will stay together with the coaches and follow Travel Regulations.

Uniforms: Please keep all Chico Cheer All Star clothing, Warm Ups and Uniform in good conditions. Please report any lost/damaged uniform items to your coach. The cost of replacements will be the responsibility of the cheerleader.

Attire: Please wear ASSIGNED gear to practice. (No jeans or jean shorts) NO jewelry to practice. Chico Cheer assumes NO responsibility for lost jewelry or any valuables.

Team Placement: All athletes are placed on a team at the discretion of the coaches. Age, experience, & ability all factor into placement. Please understand that athletes may be repositioned, moved or replaced at any time at the discretion of the coaches. Changes are made to benefit the team as a whole.

Practices: Parents are not allowed to come onto the floor for any reason. We have a designated viewing area for parents and other family members.

Discipline: If any of the above rules are compromised, the following actions will occur:

- 1st Violation: A meeting with the athlete defining the problem.
- 2nd Violation: A meeting with the athlete & the parent(s).
- 3rd Violation: The athlete may be removed from the team or entire program.

The Season:

May: Try Outs & Welcome!

June - July: Skill Building & Conditioning

August - November: Choreography & Perfecting Material

December - April: COMPETITIONS - no vacation/absences



Parent Policy:

Communication: As a parent, you will receive information in several ways, such as, monthly calendars and emails from your coach or Team Rep. Check www.ChicoCheerAllStars.com for new updates as well.

Fees: A schedule of payments is listed in this handbook. All monthly fees are due by the first practice of the month. Please make all payments at the front desk.

A late fee of \$25 will be assessed for all payments made after the second practice starts. Athletes will also be withheld from participating until payment is made. Please note payments are due even in the absence of an athlete.

All other fees are due on the exact due date. You may pay by cash, check, credit card or money order. Parents and responsible adults will be asked to sign a financial contract. Each person signing the contract will be responsible for keeping his/her child's account current. Please make all check payable to CCAS.

Monthly Tuition cannot be pro-rated for any reason. Tuition, Choreography, Camp and Nationals fees are non-refundable.

Fundraising: Fundraising is available. A different fundraiser will be presented every month. Your fundraising profits will be directly posted to your account. This involves extra work outside of cheer. However, we have seen people pay for their whole year through fundraising! Information is posted on the monthly calendar and sent home.

Any SURPLUS of credits from FUNDRAISERS can be applied towards Chico Cheer All Stars, classes, teams and merchandise. Refund checks will not be issued in the event of a surplus.

Practices: There is a viewing area designated for all parents/friends. Parents/friends are asked to stay in that designated area and not come into the training area for any reason. We want your child to get the most out of every practice. In order for this to happen, we need their full attention. If there are distractions, the whole team is affected and it may also become a safety issue.

If a parent or anyone is observed speaking negatively about a team, coach, parent, or cheerleader, he/she will be talked to and/or asked to leave. If this kind of behavior continues to be an issue, the child will have to be removed from the team. We will not tolerate this type of conduct. IF a parent verbally assaults or threatens a athlete, coach or parent, the family will be dismissed from the program.

Transportation: All transportation/accommodations to local competitions are the sole responsibility of each family. We will make every effort to provide information in a timely manner. However, if a competition is cancelled or rescheduled, Chico Cheer All Stars will not be responsible for reimbursement for any reason.

Parental Support: Your dedication and support is just important to us as your child's! Parents are encouraged to show support by wearing Chico Cheer All Stars clothing to competitions. We encourage all parents to sit together and support all CCAS teams. Showing respect for the coaching staff, other teams and hosting organizations is expected, as you are there representing Chico Cheer All Stars and your child.

3. What if I can't make try outs?

4. What if I can't tumble? Does this mean I am not going to make a "good" team?

- No! All of the Chico Cheer All Stars are "good" teams! Everyone has place a here. Tumbling is not a requirement. It is something you will learn with your staff!

5. What is the "Registration Fee?"

- The Registration Fee covers choreography and music for your athlete, rather than adding additional costs throughout the season we collect the fee immediately to book the best choreography dates possible and get started on routines early in the season!

6. What is the "USASF/IASF Athlete Membership \$25 Fee" included in our Registration?

The U.S. All Star Federation is the governing body of all star cheerleading that requires athletes to register as official members in order to compete. There are three key reasons for athletes to be members of the USASF. First is Athlete Verification, a process of verifying an athlete's age eligibility. When athletes are registered members will receive an Official USASF ID card with their birth date and Membership number which has been locked and cannot be altered. Second is Insurance. Reducing the risk of injury is an industry priority; however, despite the best effort injuries will occur. While most participants are covered through family policies the USASF does not want lack of coverage to become a long term hardship on families. They currently cover all athlete members, between ages of 3 and 25 years old, with a \$1 million catastrophic policy when supervised by a credentialed coach or credential themselves when the injury occurs. Lastly, Expanded USASF Member Benefits include a safer, more positive and cohesive competition experience, education and information for parents, athletes and coaches. Also, essential to our athletes is a fair outcome at USASF sanctioned events with educated judges. The USASF currently offers scholarship opportunities for athletes who want to pursue a higher education. Bi-monthly magazine with a focus on all star cheerleading mailed to the home and access to USASF's online monthly newsletter.
